

## **Report on the Proceedings of the PCC**

The PCC has complied with the duty under Section (5) of the Safeguarding and Clergy Discipline Measure 2016. This duty to have regard to the House of Bishops guidance on Safeguarding Children and vulnerable adults.

The PCC has met 7 times between May 2021 and April 2022, 3 of which took place on Zoom, with the remaining 4 taking place in person.

The Standing Committee has also met 7 times throughout the same period.

An additional meeting was held to complete the Diocesan Parish Self Review.
